The impact of the Rome Statute system on victims and affected communities

Statement submitted by Brazil

The achievement of the ideal of justice enshrined in the Rome Statute demands effectively addressing the concerns of victims and witnesses. We commend the initiatives undertaken by the Registry, as well as by the Trust Fund for Victims in this regard.

Over the past ten years, the Brazilian Government has been implementing actions to secure the right to protection of victims and witnesses at national level.
