The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties presents its compliments to States Parties and, on behalf of the President of the Assembly, has the honour to refer to its note verbale ICC-ASP/17/SP/02, dated 14 March 2018, and to resolution ICC-ASP/1/Res.7 on the Procedure for the nomination and election of members of the Board of Directors of the Trust Fund for the benefit of Victims, adopted by the Assembly of States Parties on 9 September 2002. Under the terms of paragraph 4 of the aforementioned resolution, the Secretariat wishes to inform States Parties that at the end of the first extension of the nomination period, as at 11 September 2018, the status of nominations received by the Secretariat was as follows:

As indicated in the table above, the number of candidates remains less than the number of seats. In light of the status of nominations indicated above, the nomination period for the members of the Board is extended for a period of two weeks to Tuesday, 25 September 2018 (Central European Time).
