<sup>1</sup> The Court's legal aid budget for the defence includes not only legal assistance to charged persons and accused, as in the other jurisdictions, but also (a) assistance to persons under Article 55(2) of the Statute and (b) appointment of counsel by a Chamber. Details of the distribution of budgeted costs are included in annex IV.

<sup>2</sup> The total allotment includes the regular 2008 budget and the use of the Contingency Fund, the budget not having taken into consideration the detainees Mr. Germain Katanga (transferred to the Court in October 2007) and Mr. Mathieu Ngudjolo Chui (transferred to the Court in February 2008). Details of the use of the Contingency Fund in these cases are provided in annex IV.

<sup>3</sup> Three of the four persons in detention have been provisionally declared indigents by the Registrar.
