The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties presents its compliments to States Parties and, on behalf of the President of the Assembly, has the honour to refer to its note verbale ICC-ASP/7/S/20, of 15 April 2008, and to resolution ICC-ASP/1/Res.5 on the procedure of the nomination and election of members of the Committee on Budget and Finance. Under the terms of paragraph 4 of the aforementioned resolution, the Secretariat wishes to inform States Parties that, as at 13 October 2008, the status of nominations for the election was as follows:

As indicated in the table above, the minimum requirements for the nomination of members of the Committee on Budget and Finance have not been met. In accordance with paragraph 4 of the resolution, the nomination period for the members of the Committee has been extended to Monday, 27 October 2008.
