- (i) Implementing legislation: a number of proposals have been circulated in the Parliament in the past and current legislature, but were not discussed due to other priorities in the political agenda. However, the Council of Minister has recently approved a new bill presented by the Minister of Justice, who has publicly stated that implementation of the Rome Statute is a priority for 2007,
- (iv) Events and activities: Italy has recently held the Conference on International Criminal Justice (Turin, 14-18 May 2007), where past, present and future activity of all international and internationalised jurisdictions was reviewed with the aim of furthering the cause of the permanent ICC,
- (vii) Contitutional issues: a number of contitutional issues have been dealt with in the ratification process, and solutions found are in detail analysed in the attached article by President Roberto Bellelli ("Italian implementation of the Rome Statute and Related Constitutional Issues", in "States' responses to issues arising from the ICC Statute: Constitutional, Sovereignty, Judicial Cooperation and Criminal Law", edited by Roy Lee, Transnational Publishers 2005),
- (viii) National contact point: upon adoption of the January 2004 EU Plan of Action implementing the 2003 EU Common Position on the ICC, the following Italian Focal Point has been established: Judge Roberto Bellelli (icc.focalpoint@esteri.it).
