I present my compliments to Your Excellency and have the honour to refer to the nomination of candidates for the election of members of the Advisory Committee on nominations of judges of the International Criminal Court.

My government has the honour to nominate Manuel Ventura Robles within the period established for this purpose. Mr. Ventura has extensive experience of over twenty five years in the area of Human Rights and International Law. He has served as Secretary of the Inter-American Court of Human Rights and is currently a judge of the Court; his mandate expires in December 2015.
