The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Slovenia presents its compliments to the Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties of the International Criminal Court and has the honour to communicate that the Government of the Republic of Slovenia decided to nominate Prof. Dr. Ernest Petrič as candidate for a member of the Advisory Committee on Nominations of Judges of the International Criminal Court.

Since the establishment of the International Criminal Court, the Republic of Slovenia has been a staunch supporter of both its work and activities. Slovenia's decision to nominate a candidate is another sign of its commitment to the effective functioning of the Court, which depends on the quality of nominated judges. An independent evaluation of candidates for the post of the ICC judge should represent the conclusive step when taking a nomination decision.

Slovenia has therefore decided to nominate an eminent international lawyer, judge, diplomat, academic and incumbent member of the Advisory Committee on Nominations of Judges of the International Criminal Court, for re-election as a member of the Committee. A detailed description of qualifications of Prof. Dr. Petrič, including his curriculum vitae, is attached to this note.
