The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties presents its compliments to States Parties and, on behalf of the President of the Assembly, has the honour to refer to its notes verbales ICC-ASP/10/S/CBF/05 and ICC-ASP/10/S/CBF/58, of 7 February and 5 September 2011, respectively, and to resolution ICC-ASP/1/Res.5 on the procedure for the nomination and election of members of the Committee on Budget and Finance. Under the terms of paragraph 4 of the aforementioned resolution, the Secretariat wishes to inform States Parties that, as at 16 September 2011, the status of nominations for the election was as follows:
