The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties presents its compliments to States Parties and, on behalf of the President of the Assembly, has the honour to refer to its note verbale ICC-ASP/16/SP/08, of 7 March 2017, and to resolution ICC-ASP/1/Res.5 on the procedure for the nomination and election of members of the Committee on Budget and Finance. Under the terms of paragraph 4 of the aforementioned resolution, the Secretariat wishes to inform States Parties that, as at 10 September 2017, the status of nominations for the election was as follows:

As indicated in the table above, the number of candidates remains less than the number of seats. In accordance with paragraph 4 of the resolution, the nomination period for the members of the Committee has been extended to Sunday, 24 September 2017.
