## **Review Conference**

The Review Conference of the Rome Statute shall be held at the Munyonyo Commonwealth Resort in Kampala, Uganda, from 31 May to 11 June 2010.

The application period for accreditation starts on Monday 10 May and closes on Monday 24 May 2010.

Press badges will be issued and handed out to journalists that have received accreditation upon presentation of a passport or a valid ID with photo. No admittance will be allowed to any of the scheduled events without prior accreditation.
