

André Laperrière is the Executive Director of the Trust Fund for Victims since January 2007. Mr Laperrière was born in Canada, where he completed graduate degrees in Industrial Relations and in Administration.

He has extensive UN and private sector experience in the Americas, Caribbean, Africa, Europe and the Middle East, especially in conflict or post conflict environments.

Mr Laperrière came to the Trust Fund from The World Health Organisation, where he was Director of the Administration and Finance Division. In this context he played a key role in the design and planning of global reforms currently taking place in WHO.

Prior to this he was responsible for UNICEF's share of the 'Oil for Food Programme' in Northern Iraq, leading reconstruction and rehabilitation efforts in Water and Sanitation, Health and Nutrition, Education and Protection.

Mr Laperrière also served in Ethiopia, Guinea, Gabon, and Haiti in addition to multiple shorter term missions in neighbouring countries.

Prior to his career in the United Nations, Mr Laperrière was Director in the International Services of Price Waterhouse, where he performed a number of assignments aiming at restoring the profitability and/or operational functionality of large scale companies or organisations around the world.
