The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties presents its compliments to States Parties and with reference to its note verbale ICC-ASP/21/S/02 of 4 February 2022, has the honour to request that the credentials for the twenty-first session of the Assembly, to be held in The Hague, from 5 to 10 December 2022, be submitted well in advance of the session. This would facilitate the work of the Credentials Committee and of the Assembly.

The credentials should be issued by the Head of State or Government, by the Minister of Foreign Affairs or by a person authorized by either of them. Changes to the names of the alternates and advisers should be communicated in writing to the Secretariat of the Assembly by the representative of the State.

Credentials should, preferably, contain the name of the representative of the State, as well as the names of the alternates and advisers, for the twenty-first session. The credentials should be submitted in an official language of the Assembly of States Parties.

Credentials should be sent to the Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties, Room A.00.49, Oude Waalsdorperweg 10, 2597 AK, The Hague, the Netherlands. Copies may also be sent via e-mail to asp@icc-cpi.int. As of 5 December 2022, credentials should be submitted directly to the Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties at the session, if possible, not later than 24 hours after the commencement of the session.
