The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties presents its compliments to States Parties and, on behalf of the President of the Assembly, has the honour to refer to its note verbale ICC-ASP/21/SP/10, of 24 June 2022 and to resolution ICC-ASP/1/Res.5 on the procedure for the nomination and election of members of the Committee on Budget and Finance. Under the terms of paragraph 4 of the aforementioned resolution, the Secretariat wishes to inform States Parties that, as at 15 September 2022, the status of nominations for the election was as follows:

As indicated in the table above, the number of candidates remains less than the number of seats in the Group of Latin American and Caribbean States. In accordance with paragraph 4 of the resolution, the nomination period for the members of the Committee has been extended to Thursday, 29 September 2022.
