



Public Information and Outreach in the Central African Republic Calendar of activities – June 2009

General objectives:

- Raise awareness among local authorities, NGOs involved in the promotion, protection and defence of human rights, and university students about the mandate, role, operation and activities of the ICC, and inform them about the confirmation of charges hearing in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo*.
- Inform the Central African population about the decision on the confirmation of charges and the committal of Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo for trial.
- Assess the partnership between the ICC and the media in the Central African Republic by means of a satisfaction survey of all Central African media.
- Make it possible for the Central African media to watch the broadcast of the public hearing of 29 June to review Jean-Pierre Bemba's detention.
