Calendar of activities – September 2010**

Overall Objectives: To increase understanding of the ICC, its mandate and activities in connection with the situation in Darfur among diverse constituencies by:

- Conducting confidential consultation meetings with key players of the society in Darfur.
- Networking with Sudanese and Arab journalists in order to promote a better understanding of the ICC judicial mandate and its work regarding Darfur.
- Producing audio programmes aiming to raise awareness among the Sudanese refugees residing in the United Nations High (UNHCR) Commissioner for Refugees' camps in Eastern Chad.

Audio Programme	01 September	The Hague, Netherlands	The Public Information and Documentation Section (PIDS) of the Registry produced the first part of an audio programme entitled "Ask the Court" which targeted the Sudanese refugees residing in the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees' (UNHCR) camps in eastern Chad. The first part of the audio programme includes 21 three-minute long episodes, each containing a question asked to the Court by a refugee, recorded in the refugee's voice, and an answer provided and recorded by the ICC. The audio programme is to be broadcast by Radio Internews, based in eastern Chad.	- Monthly detailed report - Annual outreach report

Consultation meeting	03 September	Hilversum, Netherlands	A meeting with two journalists representing Radio Dabanga was held at the Radio HQ in Hilversum, in order to negotiate the production of an audio programme that raises awareness about the work of the Court with regard to the situation in Darfur, Sudan, in particular among the Sudanese refugees in eastern Chad.	- Monthly detailed report - Annual outreach report
Consultation meeting	10 September	The Hague, Netherlands	A key representative of Sudanese associations in Europe was invited for consultations with regard to two outreach missions to Paris and Frankfurt, scheduled in October.	- Monthly detailed report - Annual outreach report
Audio drama	21 September	Hilversum, Netherlands	An agreement was reached with Radio Dabanga to re-broadcast an informative audio drama series, which includes information about the International Criminal Court and the rights of victims before the Court. The audio drama series was produced by the Public Information and Documentation Section (PIDS) in four Darfuri languages – Arabic, Fur, Zaghawa and Massalit – in order to target Sudanese refugees in eastern Chad.	- Monthly detailed report - Annual outreach report
