Trials*

- Lubanga: August 2011 closing arguments. Appeal 2012
- Katanga/Ngudjolo: Defence witnesses ongoing. 9-12 months until final decision. Appeal 2012/13
- Bemba: Prosecution witnesses will end in July. 12 -15 months until final decision. Appeal 2013
- Banda/Jerbo: Very short trial. Appeal 2012
- Mbarushimana: Trial during 2012
- Kenya 1 and 2: Trial starting at the end 2012/ beginning 2013

* Based on OTP estimations. The Defence teams can present different requests that could affect this forecast. The Judges will make the final decisions.

- DRC 3: Investigation ongoing
- DRC 4: Arrest warrant to be requested in 2012
- DRC 5: Arrest warrant to be requested in 2012/13
- Darfur 4: Investigation almost completed
- Kenya 1 and 2: Investigations ongoing
- Libya: Arrest warrant request before summer
- Libya 2 and 3: Investigations ongoing

Arrests

- Darfur case 1 and 2 (Harun and Kushayb, President Al Bashir): The Sudan has a legal obligation to cooperate. OTP needs consistent support for the implementation of the arrest warrants.
- Joseph Kony, Okot Odhiambo, Dominic Ongwen: Arrest operation needed.
- Bosco Ntaganda: OTP just needs a decision to arrest him. No excuses.

Libya Strategy

• FIRST CASE


- Focus on killings against civilians as crimes against humanity committed after 15 of February; civilian unprotected in Tripoli.
- Provisional investigative team. Provisional rotation of resources.
- No need to protect witnesses so far.

• SUBSEQUENT CASES

- Alleged war crimes committed by different parties, including rapes, force disappearances, tortures, force displacement.
- For 2011, investigative team on the basis of use of contingency fund.
