



**Public Information and Outreach in the Democratic Republic of the Congo
Calendar of activities – May 2010**

Overall objectives:

- Publicise judicial proceedings before the Court, and in particular present the defence case employed by Counsel for Thomas Lubanga, the ongoing trial of Germain Katanga and Mathieu Ngudjolo and developments in the Bemba case;
- Show and distribute videos of audio-visual programmes produced by PIDS to partners and broadcast radio programmes;
- Strengthen capabilities of partners on the ICC, journalists in particular;
- Publicise the ICC, in particular among women's groups and university groups in Kinshasa.
