## NOTE VERBALE

The Embassy of the Hellenic Republic to the Kingdom of the Netherlands presents its compliments to the International Criminal Court and, with reference to the Courts' document ICC-ASP/10/S/PA/07 of 7 February 2011 concerning the information request contained in paragraph 6, sub-paragraph (h) of the Plan of Action of the Assembly of States Parties for achieving universality and full implementation of the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court, has the honour to provide the following information:

On April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011, the Greek Parliament adopted Law 3948/2011 (Official Gazette, vol. A, No 71/5.4.2011) for the implementation of the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court.

Part A of this Law contains substantive criminal law provisions, penalizing, inter alia, the crimes falling within the jurisdiction of ICC and providing for their imprescriptibility.

Part B contains procedural rules and deals with the issue of cooperation with the International Criminal Court.
