Calendar of activities – August 2010**

Overall Objectives: To increase understanding of the ICC, its mandate and activities in connection with the situation in Darfur among diverse constituencies by:

- Conducting interactive sessions with representatives of civil society organisations from the Sudanese Diaspora based in Europe.
- Consulting representatives of affected communities residing in Europe.
- Consulting international NGOs, the media and legal communities concerned with the Darfur crisis.

Activity	Date	Place	Summary	Means of verification
Interactive session	14 August	Zurich, Switzerland	An interactive session was held in Zurich, Switzerland, targeting the Sudanese diaspora in Switzerland, with the participation of the Victims' Participation and Reparation Section (VPRS) of the Registry, and the Jurisdiction, Complementarity and Cooperation Division (JCCD) of the Office of the Prosecutor (OTP). The session aimed to explain the work of the Court with regard to the situation in Darfur and the rights of victims before the Court. Around 50 people attended the event, including lawyers, activists and women.	- Monthly detailed report - Standard evaluation

Consultation meeting	14 August	Zurich, Switzerland	A consultation meeting was held with a representative of the Darfurian community in Switzerland to exchange views on the way forward to foster greater participation of Switzerland's Darfurian community in the activities of the Court.	- Monthly detailed report
Consultation meeting	23 August	Amsterdam, The Netherlands	A follow-up meeting was held with a journalist from <i>Radio Dabanga</i> (based in the Netherlands), which targets Darfurian communities worldwide, to discuss the possibility of producing a Q&A radio programme aiming to counter misinformation about the Court in the Sudanese refugees' UNHCR camps in eastern Chad.	- Monthly detailed report
Consultation meeting	26 August	The Hague, The Netherlands	Two representatives of the non-governmental organisation "24 hours for Darfur" (based in NY), which conducted a survey entitled "Darfurian Voices" among the 12 UNHCR camps of Sudanese refugees in eastern Chad, were invited to the Court to present the survey's results. Following the briefing, Outreach exchanged views with "24 hours for Darfur" about the Outreach activities in eastern Chad.	- Monthly detailed report
