Calendar of Activities – March 2011**

**Overall Objectives:** To increase understanding of the ICC, its mandate and activities in connection with the situation in Darfur amongst diverse constituencies by:

- Conducting informative and interactive sessions with the Sudanese refugees in the UNHCR camps in eastern Chad.
- Implementing outreach educational projects in the refugee schools in the UNHCR camps in eastern Chad.
- Consulting NGOs, Media and legal communities concerned with the crisis in Darfur, in Europe and Chad, to prepare for joint activities aiming to raise awareness about the International Criminal Court among the affected communities, and to provide a greater understanding of the Court's mandate and work.
- Continuously updating and improving the outreach informative print materials about the Court and the Situation in Darfur.
- Conducting confidential meetings with key players and networking with focal points amongst the Darfuri communities residing in Europe.
