Overall Objectives: To increase understanding of the ICC, its mandate and activities in connection with the situation in Darfur among diverse constituencies by:

- Conducting interactive sessions for representatives of civil society organisations from the Sudanese Diaspora based in France and Germany.
- Conducting confidential meetings with key players among the Darfuri communities residing in Europe.
- Networking with French and German non-governmental organisations focusing on Darfur in order to promote a better understanding of the ICC judicial mandate and its work, and to reach out to broader networks of the Sudanese communities in Europe.
