## Public Information and Outreach in Sudan Calendar of activities – November 2011

**Overall Objectives:** To increase the understanding of the International Criminal Court (ICC), its mandate and activities in connection with the situation in Darfur among diverse constituencies by:

- Holding face-to-face outreach meetings with the Sudanese Diaspora living in exile.
- Developing and coordinating outreach projects aiming at raising awareness about the Court's mandate and work inside the refugee camps in eastern Chad and among the Diaspora living in exile.
- Consulting NGOs, Media and legal communities concerned with the crisis in Darfur, in Europe and elsewhere, to prepare for outreach activities aiming to raise awareness about the ICC among the affected communities, and to provide a greater understanding of the Court's mandate and work in Europe and eastern Chad.
