Sheikh Mohammed Belal, presently Ambassador of Bangladesh to the Kingdom of the Netherlands for election as a member of the Board of Directors of the Trust Fund for Victims, at the elections to be held during the seventeenth session of the Assembly of States Parties in The Hague from 5 to 12 December 2018.
