## ICC-ASP/5/Res.6

Conditions of service and compensation of judges of the International Criminal Court: amendment to the pension scheme regulations for judges of the International Criminal Court

## The Assembly of States Parties,

*Recalling* the pension scheme regulations for judges of the International Criminal Court, as contained in appendix 2 of the annex to resolution ICC-ASP/3/Res.3 of 10 September 2004,

*Pursuant* to operative paragraph 27 of resolution ICC-ASP/5/Res.3 of 1 December 2006, on strengthening the International Criminal Court and the Assembly of States Parties,

*Decides* to amend article I of appendix 2 of the annex to resolution ICC-ASP/3/Res.3 of 10 September 2004, by adding the following paragraph:

"7. No retirement pension shall be payable to a former judge who has been elected a member of the International Court of Justice or who has been elected or appointed a permanent judge of the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia or the International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda or who has been appointed to serve in the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia or the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia or the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia or the International Criminal Tribunal for the Former Yugoslavia or the International Criminal Tribunal for Rwanda as an ad litem judge until he or she ceases to hold that office or appointment."
