

**Information requested pursuant to Resolution ICC-ASP/5/Res.3-Annex I,
Plan of Action of the Assembly of States Parties for achieving universality
and full implementation of the Rome Statute of the International Criminal
Court**

Paragraph 6, sub-paragraph (h)

(i) *Information on obstacles to ratification or full implementation facing States*

Dominica deposited its instruments of acceptance of the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court on 12 February 2001. Subsequently, in 2003, Dominica drafted the International Criminal Court Bill ("ICC Bill). Dominica has not encountered difficulties as regards ratification or full implementation of the Rome Statute.

(ii) *National or regional strategies or plans of action to promote ratification and/or full implementation*

As indicated above, Dominica has already ratified the Rome Statute, and drafted an ICC Bill.

(iii) *Technical and other assistance needs and delivery programmes*

Dominica has not yet identified technical and other assistance needs and delivery programmes.

(iv) *Planned events and activities*

Apart from ratifying the Rome Statute, and drafting the ICC Bill, Dominica has not planned any events and activities as regards the Rome Statute.

(v) *Examples of implementing legislation for the Rome Statute*

Dominica's draft ICC Bill is an example of implementing legislation for the Rome Statute.

(vi) *Bilateral cooperation agreements between the Court and States Parties*

Dominica has not entered into any bilateral cooperation agreements with the Court.

(vii) *Solutions to constitutional issues arising from ratification*

Dominica has not encountered any constitutional difficulties or issues arising from ratification of the Rome Statute.
