The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties presents its compliments to the Permanent Mission of ... to the United Nations and with reference to its note verbale ICC-ASP/S/6/03 of 6 March 2007 has the honour to request that the name of the designated representative for the resumed sixth session of the Assembly, to be held in New York from 2 to 6 June 2008, be submitted well in advance of the session. This would facilitate the work of the Assembly.

The communication should, preferably, contain the name of the representative of the State, as well as the names of the alternates and advisers for the resumed sixth session.

Copies may also be sent via fax to 31-70-381-5476 or via e-mail to asp@asp.icc-cpi.int. As of 26 May 2008, all communications for the resumed sixth session should no longer be sent to The Hague, but delivered directly to the Secretariat of the Assembly at the beginning of the session, on 2 June 2008, in New York.

The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties requests that the enclosed registration form also be submitted as soon as possible, so as to expedite the work of the Assembly and the compilation of the List of Participants of the resumed sixth session.

The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties recalls that a United Nations grounds pass is required for access to United Nations premises during the resumed sixth session. Delegates not holding a valid United Nations ground pass will have to liaise through their Missions in New York. A letter signed by the Head of Chancery or Administrative Officer containing the names of participants and the completed SG 6 forms, must be sent to the Chief of Protocol of the United Nations, if possible before 28 May 2008. Once the forms have been authorized by Protocol, permanent missions are requested to deliver them to delegates, for processing at the pass and ID office.
