In parallel, Armenia is actively considering the ratification of the Agreement on the Privileges and Immunities of the Court, recognizing its critical role in ensuring effective cooperation and the Court's operational efficiency. Furthermore, we are exploring the possibility of ratifying voluntary agreements for the enforcement of sentences, which we view as another cornerstone of a robust international justice system.

Armenia also emphasizes the importance of revising the relevant provisions of the Rome Statute to harmonize the Court's jurisdiction over the crime of aggression with its jurisdiction over genocide, war crimes, and crimes against humanity. We are prepared to actively engage with other States Parties in discussions aimed at amending and aligning the Court's jurisdictional framework to ensure consistency across all four core crimes.

In conclusion, Armenia reaffirms its steadfast commitment to international justice and the principles enshrined in the Rome Statute. Through collective action and genuine cooperation, we can uphold the Court's vital role in delivering accountability and justice.
