The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties to the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court presents its compliments to States and has the honour to refer to resolution ICC-ASP/2/Res.6, which established a Trust Fund for the participation of the least developed countries in the activities of the Assembly. The Secretariat further refers to paragraph 38 of resolution ICC-ASP/4/Res.4, whereby the Assembly decided to make a provisional change to the terms of the Trust Fund to allow other developing States to draw on the Fund, so as to enhance the possibility of such States to participate in the activities of the Assembly.

In this connection, the Secretariat wishes to draw attention to paragraph 170 of resolution ICC-ASP/23/Res.1, which “[c]alls upon States, international organizations, individuals, corporations and other entities to contribute in a timely manner and voluntarily to the Trust Fund.” Contributions to the Trust Fund may be made directly to the bank account indicated in the annex. Contributions received by the Court after 9 October 2026 will be used in the subsequent calendar year.

The purpose of the Fund is to provide financial assistance, based on need and availability of funds, to representatives of least developed countries and other developing States designated by their governments, in order to cover the cost of a return air ticket as well as to provide a daily subsistence allowance. The standard travel shall be economy class, using the most direct and economical route available. The air ticket shall be prepaid by the Court, whereas the daily subsistence allowance shall be reimbursed after the session has ended.

Contingent upon the availability of funds, governments from least developed countries and other developing States interested in making use of the Trust Fund for the twenty-fifth session of the Assembly, scheduled to be held from 7 to 17 December 2026 in New York, may submit to the Secretariat an application, for one participant, using the attached form. The application should reach the Secretariat no later than 9 October 2026 and should contain the full name and contact details of the participant.

The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties avails itself of this opportunity to renew to States the assurances of its highest consideration.
