The Embassy of the Republic of Armenia in the Kingdom of the Netherlands presents its compliments to the Secretariat of the Assembly of the States Parties to the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court, and referring to the resolution ICC-ASP/3/Res.6, as amended by resolutions ICC-ASP/18/res.4, ICC-ASP/21/res.2 and ICC-ASP/23/Res.1 has the honor to inform on the following:

Armenia has not yet developed a national procedure for the nomination of candidates for judges of the International Criminal Court. A legislative package regulating the terms and conditions of cooperation between the Republic of Armenia and the International Criminal Court is currently being developed. Subsequently, after the adoption of the afore-mentioned legislative package, the relevant authorities will proceed to developing the sub-legislative acts, including but not limited to the national-level procedure for the nomination of candidates for judges of the Court. The latter will be based on the guidelines for the national-level nomination procedures of the Advisory Committee on Nomination of Judges.

Armenia is ready to provide the Advisory Committee on Nomination of Judges all the necessary assistance in preparing guidelines for the national-level nomination procedures. After completing the relevant legislative processes, Armenia will additionally inform the Secretariat on its own procedures.
