

Rome Statute 25th Anniversary Event

The 25th anniversary of the adoption of the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court (ICC) is a historic moment for the international community. To mark this important occasion, the British Embassy in Rome, in collaboration with Italy and the Dutch Embassy in Rome is organising a celebratory event to highlight the significance of the Rome Statute and the role of the ICC in promoting justice and accountability globally.

The event will feature a series of high-level speakers, including representatives from the ICC, human rights advocates and government leaders. The program also includes a panel discussion on accountability and justice for crimes committed in Ukraine and the ICC's role therein which will bring together lawyers, academics and government representatives. Q&A sessions with the audience will be interspersed throughout the programme, allowing for a productive dialogue on the various issues confronted.
