The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties presents its compliments to States Parties and, on behalf of the President of the Assembly, has the honour to refer to its note verbale note ICC-ASP/23/SP/05 of 28 March 2024 concerning the nomination period for candidates to the Advisory Committee on Nomination of Judges, and would like to inform States Parties that at the end of the nomination period on 25 August 2024, the status of nominations received by the Secretariat was as follows:

As indicated in the table above, the number of candidates remains less than the number of seats (nine). The President has, in accordance with the practice of the Bureau, extended the nomination period for the candidates for election to the Advisory Committee for a period of two weeks, to **Sunday**, **8 September 2024 (Central European Time**).
