The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties presents its compliments to States Parties and, on behalf of the President of the Assembly, has the honour to refer to its note verbale ICC-ASP/23/SP/07, of 28 March 2024 and the resolutions of the Assembly of States Parties to the Rome Statute on the establishment of the Committee on Budget and Finance, on the procedure for the nomination and election of members of the Committee on Budget and Finance, and on the election of members to the Committee on Budget and Finance of the International Criminal Court (ICC-ASP/22/Res.8). The Secretariat also refers to its note verbale ICC-ASP/23/SP/55 of 26 August 2024 concerning an extension of the nomination period for the election of five members of the Committee. Under the terms of paragraph 4 of ICC-ASP/1/Res.5, the Secretariat wishes to inform States Parties that, as at 8 September 2024, the status of nominations for the election was as follows:

As indicated in the table above, the number of candidates remains less than the number of seats in the African States, Eastern European States and Group of Latin American States. In accordance with paragraph 4 of resolution ICC-ASP/1/Res.5, the nomination period for the members of the Committee has been extended to **Sunday, 22 September 2024 (Central European Time)**.
