The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties presents its compliments to States and has the honour to refer to resolution ICC-ASP/15/Res.5 of the Assembly whereby a Trust Fund was established for the travel of the candidates from least developed countries to allow them to participate in the in-person interviews conducted by the Advisory Committee on nominations of judges, scheduled to take place from 13 to 24 July 2026 in The Hague.

The purpose of the fund is to, based on needs and availability of funds, provide financial assistance to candidates of the least developed countries and other developing States nominated by their governments in order to cover the costs of a return air ticket, as well as to provide a daily subsistence allowance. The standard travel shall be economy class, using the most direct and economical route available. The air ticket shall be prepaid by the Court, whereas the daily subsistence allowance shall be reimbursed after the Committee's meeting has ended.

The Secretariat recalls that annex I, paragraph 6(e) of resolution ICC-ASP/15/Res.5 called "upon States, international organizations, individuals, corporations and other entities to contribute voluntarily to the fund". Contributions to the Trust Fund may be made directly to the bank account indicated in the annex.
