The Embassy of Japan in the Kingdom of the Netherlands presents its compliments to the Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties to the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court, and with reference to the latter's note ICCASP/25/SP/01/Corr.2 dated 16 December 2025, has the honour to inform that the Government of Japan has decided to nominate Mr. YAMAUCHI Yoshimitsu, Director of the United Nations Asia and Far East Institute for the Prevention of Crime and the Treatment of Offenders (UNAFEI) and Ambassador for International Judicial Cooperation, as a candidate for judge of the International Criminal Court for the term 2027 to 2036, at the elections to be held during the twenty-fifth session of the Assembly of States Parties scheduled for 7 to 17 December 2026.

Mr. Yamauchi is a candidate on the List A for the purpose of article 36, paragraph 5 of the Rome Statute and is being nominated following the procedure for the nomination of candidates for appointment to the highest judicial offices in Japan.
