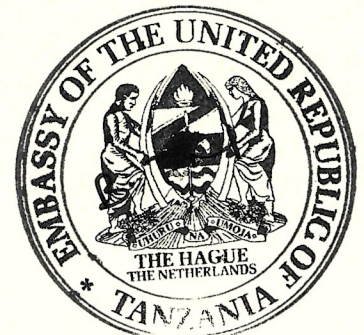

ICC-ASP/23/SP/07 informing that the nomination period for the candidates for five seats on the Committee on Budget and Finance ("the Committee") will run from 03 June to 25 August 2024 (Central European Time).
