The Embassy of the Republic of Armenia to the Kingdom of the Netherlands presents its compliments to the Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties to the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court and, with reference to paragraph 6(h)(v) of the Plan of Action adopted by the Assembly through Resolution ICC-ASP/5/Res.3 of 1 December 2006, in particular with regard to the legislative measures undertaken for the implementation of the Rome Statute, has the honour to inform that:

Pursuant to Decision No. N 153-A of the Prime Minister of the Republic of Armenia, dated 19 February 2024, entitled "On the Approval of the Program and Schedule of Measures Ensuring the Implementation of the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court," a comprehensive action plan has been adopted.

Within the framework of its implementation, and as a result of the work carried out thus far, relevant legislative amendments have been jointly initiated by the Ministry of Justice and the Office of the Prosecutor General of the Republic of Armenia. These amendments concern the Law HO-464-N of 15 November 2024, "On Legal Assistance in Criminal Proceedings," and the Law HO-141-N of 10 July 2019, "On the Representative in International Legal Matters."

Public hearings have been held on the draft laws, and the feedback received from various government agencies as well as from participants in the hearings is currently being summarized.

The Embassy of the Republic of Armenia to the Kingdom of the Netherlands avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties the assurances of its highest consideration.
