The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties presents its compliments to States Parties and, on behalf of the President of the Assembly, has the honour to refer to its notes ICC-ASP/8/S/18, ICC-ASP/8/S/29 and ICC-ASP/8/S/30, dated 24 April, 12 and 26 August 2009, respectively, and to resolution ICC-ASP/1/Res.7 on the Procedure for the nomination and election of members of the Board of Directors of the Trust Fund for the benefit of Victims, adopted by the Assembly of States Parties on 9 September 2002. Under the terms of paragraph 4 of the aforementioned resolution, the Secretariat wishes to inform States Parties that, as at 9 September 2009, the status of nominations received by the Secretariat was as follows:

As indicated in the table above, the number of candidates remains less than the number of seats. In accordance with paragraph 4 of the aforementioned resolution, the nomination period for the members of the Board has been extended for a third time, to <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>22</u> <u>September 2009</u> (Central European Time).
