Corrigendum

Page 8, paragraph 26:

Insert the following paragraph after paragraph 26:

26.*bis* Operations. The removal from the draft Action Plan of an even permissive language whereby the Court was encouraged to consider the establishment of a dedicated in-house professional directly reporting to the Prosecutor so as to enhance¹ prospects of arrests, does not retain the successful experiences of the other international and internationalized jurisdictions.

¹ Purposes of such capacity would have been: (a) Providing an agile and flexible tracking capacity, including on financial matters, mostly deployed on the field and capable of performing with appropriate informal techniques, (b) Interacting swiftly and generating trust with interlocutors in the field, (c) Collecting independent intelligence, and coordinating local and other Agencies' activities, (d) Developing execution-ready requests for the local Authorities, (e) Supporting the high level contacts of the Prosecutor on non-cooperation matters, and (f) Performing any other tasks as they might be conferred to it by the Prosecutor.
