The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties presents its compliments to the Permanent Mission of ... to the United Nations and with reference to its notes verbales ICC-ASP/7/S/09 of 9 April 2008 and ICC-ASP/7/OS/53 of 23 October 2008, has the honour to request that the names of designated representatives of Observer States, and of alternates and advisers who accompany them, for the first and second resumptions of the seventh session of the Assembly of States Parties to be held at United Nations Headquarters in New York, from 19 to 23 January and from 9 to 13 February 2009, be submitted well in advance of the session. This would facilitate the work of the Assembly.

The communication should, preferably, contain the name of the representative of the Observer State, as well as the names of the alternates and advisers for the first and second resumptions of the seventh session.

Copies may also be sent via fax to +31-70-381-5476 or via e-mail to asp@asp.icc-cpi.int. As of 12 January 2009, all communications for the first and second resumptions of the seventh session should no longer be sent to The Hague, but delivered directly to the Secretariat of the Assembly, on 19 January and on 9 February, respectively, in Conference Room E at United Nations Headquarters in New York.

The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties requests that the enclosed registration form be submitted as soon as possible, so as to expedite the compilation of the Lists of Participants to the first and second resumptions of the seventh session.

The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties recalls that a United Nations grounds pass is required for access to United Nations premises during both resumptions of the seventh session. Delegates not holding a valid United Nations grounds pass will have to liaise through their Missions in New York. A letter signed by the Head of Chancery or Administrative Officer containing the names of participants and the completed SG.6 forms, must be sent to the Chief of Protocol of the United Nations. Authorized applications will only be available for collection 48 hours (2 working days) after submission. Permanent missions are requested to deliver them to delegates, for processing at the United Nations Pass and ID office.
