The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties presents its compliments to States Parties and, on behalf of the President of the Assembly, has the honour to refer to its note verbale ICC-ASP/20/SP/38, dated 3 June 2021 and to resolution ICC-ASP/1/Res.7 on the Procedure for the nomination and election of members of the Board of Directors of the Trust Fund for the benefit of Victims, adopted by the Assembly of States Parties on 9 September 2002. Under the terms of paragraph 4 of the aforementioned resolution, the Secretariat wishes to inform States Parties that at the end of the nomination period, on 29 August 2021, the status of nominations received by the Secretariat was as follows:

As indicated in the table above, the number of candidates remains less than the number of seats in one regional group, the Asia-Pacific group. In light of the status of nominations indicated above, the President has, pursuant to resolution ICC-ASP/1/Res.7, extended the nomination period for a period of two weeks, until <u>Sunday</u>, 12 <u>September 2021</u> (<u>Central European Time</u>).
