1) Fourteenth session of the Assembly of States Parties

a) Organization of work

The Bureau decided to allocate 90 minutes of the seventh plenary meeting, on 20 November 2015, to a high-level debate of agenda items 21 and 22. A 45 minute period would be allocated to the consideration of agenda item 21, proposed by South Africa, followed by a 45 minute period for consideration of agenda item 22, proposed by Kenya. Each proponent would be requested to introduce the respective agenda item, which would be followed by interventions by other delegations. The Bureau recommended that there be balance of the wider membership of the Assembly in the responses of States Parties and that States consider making interventions on behalf of groups.
