Subject: Election of the candidate to be nominated to the International Criminal Court

Dear Sir/Madam,

With regard to the referenced acts, we hereby notify you that the High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council of Bosnia and Herzegovina (hereinafter: the Council), after conducting a procedure, at the Council's session on 30 April 2020, selected judge Jasmina Cosic Dedovic as a candidate whom Bosnia and Herzegovina will nominate for a judge at the International Criminal Court.

In addition, we herewith submit additional information, which confirm that the proposed candidate fulfils the requirements from Article 36, paragraph 3 of the Rome Statute (hereinafter: the Statute) as follows:

1. A Curriculum Vitae (CV) of the judge Jasmina Cosic Dedovic - in English enclosed,

2. A statement with a detailed overview how the candidate Jasmina Cosic Dedovic fulfils the nomination requirements.

The statement is submitted according to Article 36, paragraph 4 of the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court and the Resolution ICC-ASP/3/Res.6, supplemented by the Resolution ICC-ASP/5/Res.5 and ICC-ASP/12/Res.8, annex II and ICC-ASP/14/Res.4, annex II that refer to the procedures of nomination and election of judges of the International Criminal Court.

Since 30 April 2020 is the final deadline to nominate candidates to the international Criminal Court, we ask you to urgently submit the candidate's nomination to the Secretariat of the Assembly of State Parties to the Rome Statute through diplomatic channels.
