

The Secretariat of the Assembly of States Parties presents its compliments to the Permanent Mission of ..... to the United Nations and, on behalf of the President of the Assembly, has the honour to refer to its notes ICC-ASP/5/S/10 and ICC-ASP/5/S/11, of 5 June and 29 August 2006, respectively, on the nomination and election of the five members of the Board of Directors of the Trust Fund for the benefit of victims. On 29 September 2006, Kenya informed the Secretariat that it had withdrawn its candidature.

Accordingly, as at 2 October 2006, the following nominations were received by the Secretariat:

As indicated in the table above, the minimum requirements for the nomination of members of the Board of Directors of the Trust Fund for the benefit of victims have not been met. In accordance with paragraph 4 of resolution ICC-ASP/1/Res.5, the nomination period for the members of the Board has been extended once more, to Sunday, 15 October 2006 (Central European Time).
