1) The Republic of Tajikistan became a party to the Rome Statute of the ICC on December 19, 1999. The article 10 of the Constitution of the Republic of Tajikistan, which is the country's principle law, states that international and legal acts recognized by Tajikistan are part and parcel of the legal system of the Republic, and, for this reason, the provisions of the Rome Statute of the ICC are envisaged by the normative and legal acts of the Republic of Tajikistan.

2) The Government of the Republic of Tajikistan has established a Commission for implementation of the norms of the international humanitarian law, which is in charge of the national strategy on their implementation.

3) As of today, no information is available concerning application of the norms of the Rome Statute of the ICC by the courts of the Republic of Tajikistan.
